Brent Lambiotte earned his BA Degree in Industrial Technology from Fairmont State University, did post graduate work at West Virginia University and earned his MBA from Ohio State University.

As Transportation Coordinator at Kaiser Aluminum & Chemical's Ravenswood, WV Sheet, Plate and Foil works, he was responsible for worldwide distribution of finished products. At Kaiser's Newark, OH Rod, Bar and Wire facility, he was Distribution Superintendent and was responsible for order fulfillment and inbound and outbound logistics. He was Administrator of the Logistics Department at Honda of America Manufacturing in Marysville, Ohio. There, he was responsible for the supply chain for Honda's two automobile assembly plants, the engine plant and the motorcycle plant.

Lambiotte joined Mercedes-Benz U.S. International, Inc. (MBUSI) in 1994, and held a variety of positions until the end of 2006.
